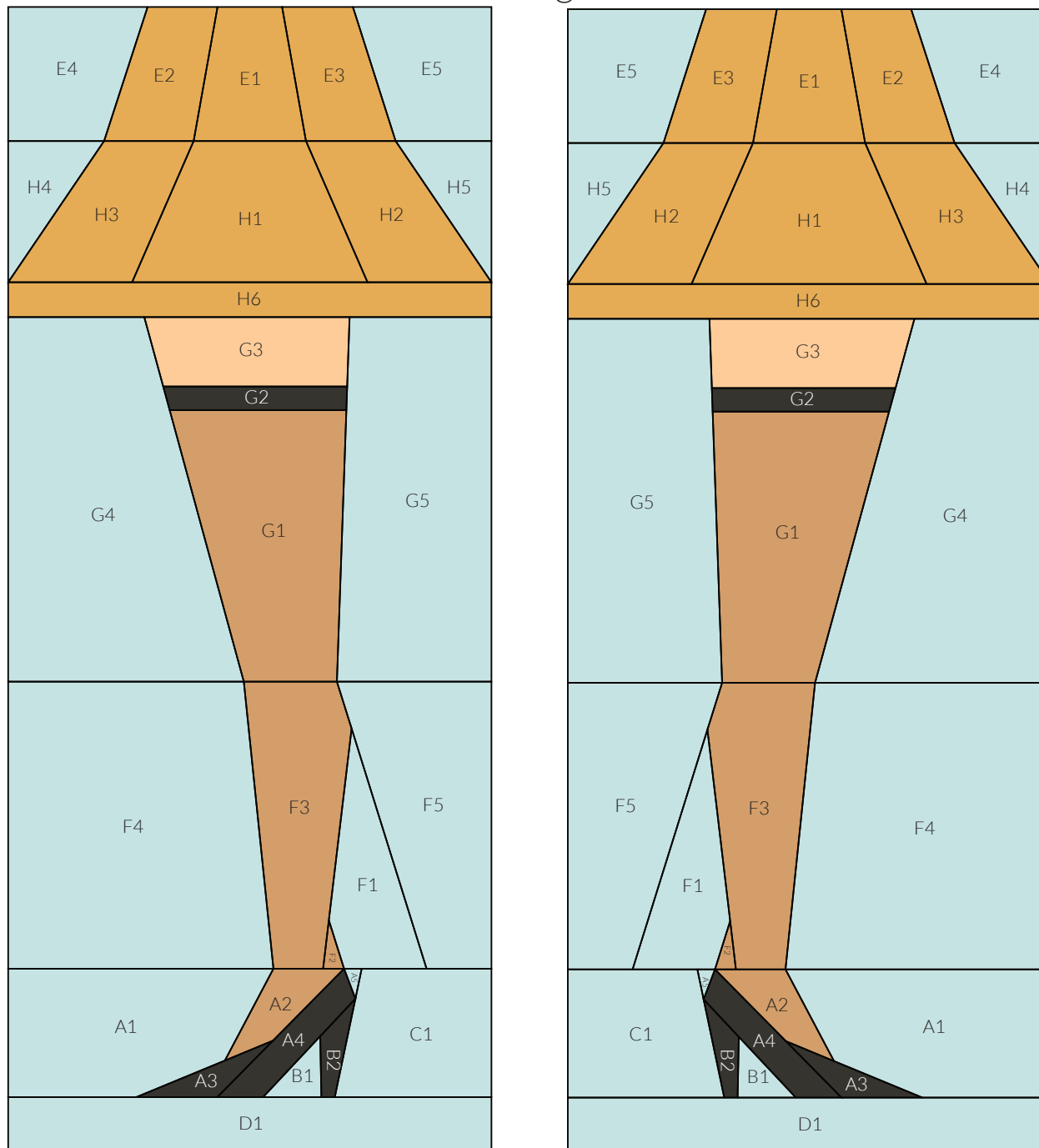


Sew What Sherlock's Leg Lamp

Assembly Instructions

Finishes 20" high x ~8" wide



Instructions

1. Paper piece each template piece as you normally would. Units C1 and D1 are just single pieces cut to size. D can be omitted as needed. It just makes the block a full 20" height.
2. Attach the B unit to the A unit. Attach the C unit to the new AB unit.
3. Assemble each row of units from the bottom up. Attach ABC -> F, ABCF -> G, ABCFG -> H, and ABCFGH -> E.
4. Add trim over unit H6 if desired. Enjoy your new leg lamp!

Tips: I prefer to remove the paper before attaching large sections together. It's a personal preference. In my sample I used a piece of nylon netting on top of a flesh colored quilting cotton to make the stocking. Just sew the two pieces of material as if they are one, using a pin to keep the netting in place when needed. I also used a textured microsuede for the shoe and a lightweight shiny home decor fabric for the lampshade. Test all your materials with an old iron before using them to paper piece, as some may melt! Surprisingly my netting did not melt, give it a shot!

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
